

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Bryn Mawr College Retirement Plan

This is a summary of the annual report Form 5500 Annual Return/Report of Employee Benefit Plan for Bryn Mawr College Retirement Plan EIN 23-1352621, Plan No. 001, for period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. The Form 5500 annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). Your plan is a single employer defined contribution plan.

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by insurance and a trust fund. Plan expenses were \$21,289,213. These expenses include \$129,097 in administrative expenses, \$21,092,041 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$68,075 in other expenses. A total of 2,012 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$306,015,598 as of December 31, 2023, compared to \$274,923,781 as of January 1, 2023. During the plan year the plan experienced a
