The successful candidate's research may be on Latin poetry from any period, and they should also display expertise in classical reception studies in any medium, which might facilitate collaboration with other departments and programs at the college (e.g., Africana Studies, International Studies, Comparative Literature). We seek a candidate who will be able to teach Roman culture including core canonical texts and Latin at all levels. The successful candidate will be expected to be part of developing and teaching a diverse and inclusive curriculum, including graduate seminars, interdisciplinary programs and other college initiatives such as the 360 Program and the first-year Emily Balch Seminars. Candidates must have completed Ph.D. requirements by the start date.

To apply for this position, candidates must submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statement of teaching philosophy, research statement, and statement of demonstrated commitment to diversity and inclusion. Candidates should also submit a writing sample of not more than 10,000 words in length and two sample syllabi, one for a second-year Classical Studies course and one for a graduate seminar.
